2024 LEAGUE INFORMATION

General

- Rules session & new member orientation on April 24th, 2024, from 4-6pm (No Golf)
- Opening Night Party and first day of play is May 1st
- League play will be on Wednesdays from May 1st October 2nd
- Golfers of all abilities age 18 and older may compete and may choose to play 9 or 18-holes each week
- Handicap indexes of **14.9 or lower** will play from the WHITE tees, **15.0 or higher** will play RED tees
- Ladies' League Happy Hour all-day on Wednesdays
- The league will have a maximum of 200 members
- All league events will have Indian Peaks' shared cart policy in effect
- **League Members must play in at least three (3) league events to guarantee their spot in 2025**
 - Those who play fewer than 3 events may register with general public for the 2025 league.

Tee Time Registration/Cancellation/Changes

- Tee time registration is available **online only**, 2 weeks in advance
- Tee time requests will be accepted in the order they are received
 - o Registrations will open at <u>7am MST</u> each <u>Thursday</u>, two weeks in advance of each event
- Please do not register anyone for play without their prior consent!
- **The third Wednesday of each month will be individual sign-ups only (no group registrations). **
- The final tee time slot will be two and a half (2 ½) hours before sunset, to allow players to finish before dark
- Weekly Tee Times will be posted online by end of day of the Saturday before Wednesday's play; please make any necessary changes or cancellations prior to 5 pm Monday for that week's event
- **Cancellations after Monday at 5 pm are subject to charge; Same-day cancellations will be charged.**

Handicaps/Payouts

- WE WILL POST ALL LEAGUE SCORES FOR YOU. PLAYERS DO NOT ENTER LEAGUE SCORES!
- For league purposes, the maximum number of strokes you can take on any hole is <u>DOUBLE PAR</u>.
- Lt is the players responsibility to post all scores played outside of the Ladies' League
- For posting rounds *outside* of the league, the maximum per hole score will depend on your handicap:
 - The World Handicap System uses "Net Double Bogey" as a replacement for the past ESC scores.
 This means that for posting, the most you can post per hole is a double bogey, after applying your handicap for each hole.
- **Each week will also feature two contests (longest putt, long drive, closest to pin...etc.) for prize money**
- Events will be flighted, and payouts will use a combination of Gross and Net scoring within flights, with one (1) Gross winner and four (4) Net winners per flight* (subject to change depending on # of players)
 - Ties will be decided by a scorecard playoff, using the USGA's preferred method of sum of last 6 holes, then last 3, then the final hole, and finally by hole handicap should there still be a tie.

2024 LEAGUE INFORMATION

Rules of Play

- USGA rules of golf will govern all play
- It is the player's responsibility to know and abide by the rules of play
- Breach of rules will result in disqualification
- 'Cita Rules' may be used to play just for fun: you must declare **before the start of play** that you won't use strict USGA rules and are playing just for fun but are therefore unable to win prize money for that week. *If chosen, denote 'Cita Rules' on scorecard, or simply do not turn in a scorecard upon completion of play. Weekly prize fund contributions are not optional.*

Scoring/Rules Disputes

- Players are responsible for keeping an accurate hole-by-hole score in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf and verifying scores with two signatures upon completion of play.
- The official scorecards must be returned with two signatures attesting the accuracy of each player's score. It is <u>each player's responsibility</u> to verify correct number of strokes taken per hole.
- Players should write in competitors' score on the *following* tee box (<u>not</u> while still on the green); settle any quick concerns at that time
- Questions about the rules or disputes must be resolved with the tournament director immediately following play and before signing the scorecard

Prize Fund and Golf Shop Credit Awards

- Weekly prize funds will be collected and distributed based on the day's event
- Golf shop credits are good for merchandise only
 - o Members may use shop credits towards special orders
- Golf shop credits will expire on November 30, 2024
- In-Stock Clothing & Headwear are discounted 25% for league members, year round

Inclement Weather

- It's going to rain a few times, so be prepared for a shower or two. Cancellation of the day's event due to inclement weather will be <u>solely</u> at the discretion of the tournament committee; you will be notified via email if the event is cancelled
- A mere *possibility* of rain does not constitute a valid reason for cancellations after 5pm on Monday prior to Wednesday's play

Pace of Play

- 9 holes should be completed in approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes, 18 holes in 4 hours and 30 minutes
- Encourage others to keep the pace and offer tips to newer players on how to do so
- A faster pace on the course can improve your performance and will certainly improve the experience for all of those following behind you!
- Some quick tips include: playing ready golf, taking only one practice swing, getting your yardage while others are playing, continuously putting, and leaving the flagstick in the hole while putting

2024 LADIES' LEAGUE TOURNAMENT FORMATS

Formats will be flighted by handicap

Team Scramble

Players will be grouped into teams. On each hole, all players will tee off and then choose the ball they wish to be played for the next shot. All other players will then pick up their balls and place them at the ball chosen to be played, and all hit from that spot. That process will be repeated until the ball is holed by any player. Each group will only have one score per hole. All players must play from the same condition of turf of chosen ball: if the chosen ball is in the fairway, all players must stay in fairway, ball in rough must stay in rough, ball in sand must stay in sand...etc. (50% of combined handicap)

Best Ball

All players will play their own ball on each hole, and the best score per hole will count for the team. (90% of individual handicap)

Individual Stroke Play

All players will keep individual scores and play with normal USGA rules. (Full Handicap)

Mystery Holes

Players will keep score on each hole, however only five holes will count for scoring (55% handicap). These holes will only be unveiled following the completion of play, so play them all as best you can since you won't know which holes will count! 18-Hole players will have 10 scores count (5 scores on front nine, 5 on back nine)

Contest Holes

Players will play their own ball on every hole. In addition to the stroke play competition, on each hole there will be a special contest, which will win prize money. Players may win more than one contest! **(Full Handicap)**

Beat the Pro

Players will play their own ball on each hole. The pro will play from the back tees, and <u>all</u> players who beat the pro's 9- hole score (with handicap) will win prize money! **(Full Handicap)** **This event is <u>not</u> flighted**

Blind 2-Lady Best Ball

Players are randomly paired with another league player, who will be discovered after completion of play. Each player will play their own ball on each hole, and the best score per hole will count for the pair.

(90% of individual handicap)

Heaven & Hell

Even holes will be played from Red Tees, you may remove the ball from sand traps without penalty (no closer to the hole), use one (1) mulligan on ANY heaven hole (only 1 mulligan per round), and have a max of 2-Putts (from once the ball is on the green).

Odd holes will be played from the White Tees, all normal USGA rules apply, and there is no maximum number of putts (putt the ball all the way into hole). **(Full Handicap)**

4-Club Tournament

Players will play their own ball on each hole and will be limited to only four (4) clubs of their choosing. Putters are to be counted as one of the four clubs, should you choose to use a putter. **(Full Handicap)** * *Entering score for handicaps are optional for this round.* *

2024 LADIES' LEAGUE TOURNAMENT FORMATS

Formats will be flighted by handicap

3-2-1 Team Best Ball

Players in each tee time are made into a team, which will compete against the other teams. Each player will play their own ball on each hole, with three (3) scores counting on Par 3's. two (2) scores counting on Par 4's, and only one (1) score counting on Par 5's towards the team's overall score. (90% of individual handicap)

"Step Away" Scramble

Players will be grouped into teams. On each hole, all players will tee off and then choose the ball they wish to be played for the next shot. All players will then pick up their balls and place them at the ball chosen to be played, and team members will hit from that location. **IMPORTANT: The player whose ball is selected CANNOT** hit from that location. That process will be repeated until the ball is holed. Each group will only have one score per hole. All players must play from the same condition of turf of chosen ball: if the chosen ball is in the fairway, all players must stay in fairway, ball in rough must stay in rough, ball in sand must stay in sand...etc. (50% of combined handicap)

Club Championship **(2 ROUND EVENT)**

Players will play their own ball on each hole, and the two-round totals will determine Flight Champions. Players **MUST** play **BOTH** rounds to be eligible for Club Championship Prizes. Players may choose to play only one of the two rounds; however, they will be ineligible to win prize money. **(Full Handicap)**

Karma Golf

Each group will receive a 'Karma Ball' and alternate who plays this ball every hole, keeping the score of the Karma ball in addition to each individual's score. Those groups who return with the Karma ball will have their Karma score count for the competition. (50% of combined handicap)

Generously Modified Stableford

Players will play their own ball on every hole. Net scores relative to par will be worth different amounts of points, and the most points will win! *Eagle or better = 10 pts., Birdies = 8 pts., Pars = 5 pts., Bogeys = 3 pts., Double Bogey = 1 pt., Triple Bogey or worse = 0 pts.* (Full Handicap)

Playing the Odds...or Evens? **NEW FORMAT**

Players will play their own ball on each hole. Once all players complete play, either only the odd or even holes will count for the competition. Since you won't know which half will count until after you play, try hard on all of them! (50% of individual handicap)

NFL Week

All players will play their own ball on each hole. Similar to Generously Modified Stableford (see above), net scores on each hole will be worth different amounts of points, with the most points winning! *Eagle or better = 11 pts.* (Touchdown w/2-pt conversion and game winning field goal), Birdies = 8 pts. (Touchdown w/ 2-pt conversion), Pars = 7 pts. (Touchdown w/ extra point), Bogeys = 6 pts. (Touchdown w/ missed extra point), Double Bogeys = 3 pts. (Field goal), and Triple bogeys or worse = -2 pts. (Safety) (Full Handicap)
