

COVID-19 Status Update - Indian Peaks Golf Course

Indian Peaks Golf Course has reopened to public with guidelines in place

If you are feeling sick, stay away until you are healthy. We'll still be here for you.

As approved by the Boulder County Public Health Department and the City of Lafayette, Indian Peaks Golf Course has reopened with strict guidelines in place. Our highest priority is the health and safety of our staff and guests.

- Credit card only, no cash accepted.
- Masks are REQUIRED when entering the Clubhouse, Golf Shop, or Grill. Please maintain 6' social distancing.
- Golf Carts may be shared for those living in the same household, for those where both persons have been fully vaccinated for Covid-19, or when both persons where a mask while riding in the cart.
- If you have fewer than 4 players, you will be paired with others to make a group of 4.
- Golf Shop is OPEN. A limited number of guests are allowed in the Golf Shop at any one time. Please practice 6' social distancing at all times.
- Practice facilities are OPEN. Social distancing of 6' must be maintained at all times.
- "The Peaks" Bar & Grill is OPEN for indoor seating at 50% capacity. Outside patio is also OPEN.
- Club Rentals are not available at this time. All players must have a set of clubs.

Our highest priority continues to be the health and safety of our staff and all guests who come to Indian Peaks. Golfers are asked to please help keep the golf course open by adhering to and respecting the safety guidelines that we've implemented. Golf Club staff will be strictly enforcing the safety guidelines. Guests that cannot adhere to or respect the guidelines will politely be asked to leave.
